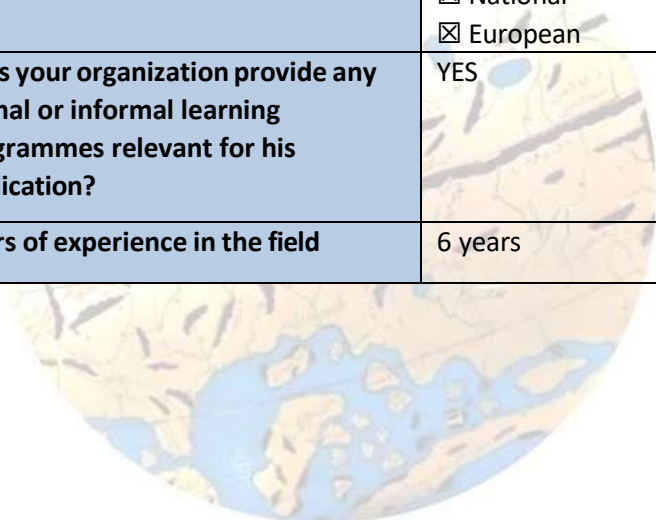

ORGANISATION PROFILE

IDRISI Cultura e Sviluppo ETS is a non-profit association in Palermo (Sicily, Italy) that incorporates all the elements of social and cultural value capable of developing educative and economic initiatives, whose aim is to put economy, culture and society on the same level. The Association, born from the experiences of its the founding members, adopts proactive, structured and widely shared measures, in order to promote cultural participation as one of the main axes of a new cohesive and active citizenship, supporting the dissemination of education and knowledge as factors development capable of contributing to the growth of knowledge capital. For this reason, the members shared their rich curriculum of experiences gained individually, giving life to the association to develop actions, projects, cultural and educational activities to support all those development factors necessary for the dissemination of culture in general. In particular, Idrisi promotes any formal informal and non-formal learning activity in order to improve lifelong competences, skills and knowledge in a personal, civic and social perspective, as well as the promotion of intercultural and inclusive dialogue, supporting diversity. The association's purpose is in fact to strengthen the interaction between the educational sector and other sectors, for example the ones related to culture, creativity and activism. Idrisi strives to provide a quality educational offer, focusing in particular on contributions which came from the participation in incubators, new technologies and collaborative models, both in Italy and abroad, pursuing the concept of sustainable and inclusive development for a better quality of life, proposing activities aimed at strengthening the links between culture and education, social policies, democracy, research and innovation. The association has a range of statutory purposes in line with the skills of the founding members. It is equipped with various professional figures including researchers, teachers, counselors, experts in cultural heritage, marketing, legal and administrative, experts in European planning. One of the purposes of Idrisi Cultura e Sviluppo ETS is to develop solutions aimed at combating phenomena of intolerance, marginality and exclusion, focusing attention on various vulnerable categories and carrying out a continuous awareness-raising activity towards local public and / or private institutions. The Association is able to develop services aimed at eliminating the causes that prevent the integration of vulnerable categories (e.g. Youth, NEETs, women) in the socio-economic fabric, fostering democratic participation. Idrisi Cultura e Sviluppo ETS therefore supports the entire education - training - work supply chain, considering it as a unicum with the person and its growth and learning path at the center. The members of staff involved in Idrisi's projects have personal skills acquired and implemented during their respective careers: these are accompanied by transversal skills acquired thanks to the various activities carried out in the non-profit sector, mainly in Italy but also abroad. The staff involved has the skills required to establish and manage relationships with teams of professionals, including international ones, providing their experience and the ability to create consistent relationships for the development of projects in the field of Education, as well as the ability to build bridges with reliable partners.

BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

Idrisi Cultura e Sviluppo ETS aims to bring the individual knowledge capital of its members into the curriculum. Their years of experience in planning and managing educational and training interventions, also co-financed by the EU, have been focused on the management of territorial animation, supporting the birth of new educative modules. The goal of these activities is to fill up the knowledge gap by developing modules designed to contrast educational deprivation. The staff of Idrisi Cultura e Sviluppo ETS has activated an analysis and research section for the creation of socially inclusive paths and in favor of vulnerable categories. The association is committed to the construction of initiatives related to the aforementioned topics, such as: SOCIAL INCLUSION; UPSKILLING: European Social Fund, Sicilian Regional Operational Program 2014-2020, Actions 9.2.1 and 9.2.2, Call 30/2019 "Training of disabled, vulnerable and at risk of discrimination. Co-planning of high-level education and training interventions. level aimed at enhancing and supporting disadvantaged and less represented categories (women, people with disabilities, migrants), IDI ICT Palermo.

Within the Erasmus + framework, the association currently implements educational and training courses in favor of disadvantaged territories and communities. The first project, promoted by Idrisi, is Bucolico (Building Community Resilience through Communication & Technology, KA204): an educational prototype designed for young NEETs in the European rural area for the acquisition of digital and entrepreneurial skills especially through the involvement of role models. Idrisi is also a partner of Insides (Innovative Training Settings for the Self Development of Emerging Artists, KA227), a non-formal and informal learning path for young European artists and depressed urban contexts: an original production of street art as a growth medium. Idrisi is also the promoter of Astra (Advancing Sustainable Transition and Resilience in post-mining Areas, KA227), a project for the regeneration of depressed European mining settings by digital means. All the projects of which the association is a promoter and / or partner have therefore placed at the center the potential of formal, non-formal and informal education, of experiential dynamism, also working in close contact with local communities and institutional stakeholders. In 2021 Idrisi chose to undertake a statutory strengthening process, committing itself to contribute to the realization of the community strategy for gender equality 2020-2025 and the announced strategy on LGBTIQ Equality (2020 State of the Union), acting in the educational field, stimulating political-democratic awareness and participation. These priorities, already widely present in the association statute, have led Idrisi to weave fruitful relationships with Italian educating communities (first and second grade public and private schools, youth workers) and to orient its project priorities in this sense. Moreover, Idrisi Cultura e Sviluppo ETS is at work in order to build up innovative educational spaces, intimately linked to the local cultural heritage, which can function as poles of excellence to promote environmental sustainability and well-being, in collaboration with high-level local networks.
